Consumer advocacy lands LJ Hooker Settlements plaudits

LJ Hooker Settlements' consumer protection innovations have been recognised by the WA Department of Commerce.

The St Georges Terrace agency was nominated in the Department of Commerce's 2016 Consumer Protection Awards in recognition for their contributions to making the market better equipped to make real estate decisions.

In response to Perth's increasingly multicultural community, LJ Hooker Settlements created a step-by-step flowchart of the transaction process in WA in six non-English languages.

The office also created an 'e-book' titled 'Ten Potential Disasters' which alerted buyers and sellers to the pitfalls in common real estate transactions. It also created a real estate agent industry education awareness video around transactions.

LJ Hooker Settlements' motivation to make the practice of buying and selling safer and hassle-free stemmed from unfortunate incidents in 2010 and 2011, when two Perth home owners were effectively robbed of their homes and assets as a result of identity theft.
